Every second Sunday of September, the Commemoration Ceremony dedicated to the anniversary of liberation of Maldegem and neighbouring towns in WWII is held at the local War Cemetery, where are the graves of the liberators: soldiers of the 1st Polish and the 4th Canadian Armoured Divisions.

In the future, from 2018 onwards, the ceremony at the cemetery shall be preceded by 2-day "World General Maczek Fan Jamboree", one of many events within the frame of "Liberation Route of the 1st Polish Armoured Division of General Maczek" Programme. The fans with their tents and campers, will be located at the park of the Canada-Poland Museum in Adegem.

The Maczek Jamboree shall become the leading event on the patriotic-themed route of the towns and villages liberated by General Maczek; they, according to the organizers plans, are to be visited by the Poles who would wish to refresh or gain the personal knowledge of the places which have got their freedom from the hands of their grand-fathers.

The lesson learned from this year, first Jamboree, will let the organizers shape it regarding the profile and number of participants, the programme rules, logistics, promotion, financing etc.



Framework Programme

Saturday, 8th September 2018

12.00-23.00 Arrival and registration of participants

You will be located (with your own camper / tent on the Forest Site of the Museum (see pictures). Also, you can choose to stay at one of nearest hotels / hostels / airb&b (booking and transport is your own responsibility).





16.30-17.30 Official opening of the Jamboree by:

Jerzy Samborski – the author and organizer of the World General Maczek Fan Jamboree Gilbert Landschoot – the creator and owner of the Canada-Poland Museum

Presentations and speeches representatives of the partners and guests: Association of the 1st Polish Armoured Division in Belgium and others (tbc)

Venue: the Foreyard of the Museum or the Museum Hall – depending on the weather (see the picture).



17.30-19.00 Visiting Canada-Poland Museum

Paid individually on the spot (€ 7 for each museum) or price included in the pre-paid "Jamboree Package"



19.00-20.00 Evening meal

The Museum restaurant special offer "Maczek Jamboree Big Breadboard" with coffee /tea / beer / glass of wine.

20.00-23.00 Bon-fire

Continuation of presentations and speeches, showing films, joint singing songs, dancing. Bar stays open till 23.00.

Own stuff or coffee / tea at the bar – \in 2.7, paid on the spot or pre-ordered in "Jamboree Package". The restaurant will be open at 12.00.

08.00 – 09.00 Jamboree Morning Muster

With the participation of the official Polish Delegation headed by Mrs. Anna Maria Anders - Senator, Secretary of State, Plenipotentiary for International Dialogue (the daughter of General Władysław Anders, Commander of the 2nd Polish Corps in the West, the latest Polish immediate superior of General Maczek), Mr. Artur Orzechowski – Polish Ambassador and others. Hoisting Polish flag and singing the Polish National Anthem.

09.00 - 09.30 March from the Museum to Maldegem Military Cemetery (2 km)



09.30-12.00 Official Commemoration Ceremony

The event is organized by the Maldegem Authority in commemoration of soldiers of the 1st Polish Armoured Division of General Maczek and other Liberators of Adegem and Flanders.

Speeches of the Representative of the King Philip I, Minister Anna Maria Anders, Polish Ambassador Artur Orzechowski, Mayor of Maldegem Marleen Van den Bussche and other VIPs, laying wreaths/flowers at the monument and the graves of Polish soldiers. 12.30 – 13.30 Lunch

The Museum and restaurant are open on: Saturday till 23.00 (kitchen till 20.00), Sunday till 18.00 (kitchen open 12.00 – 18.00).

The nearest Supermarket is in Maldegem (2 km from the Museum).

Washing and toilets are available inside of the Museum building till 23.00.
